

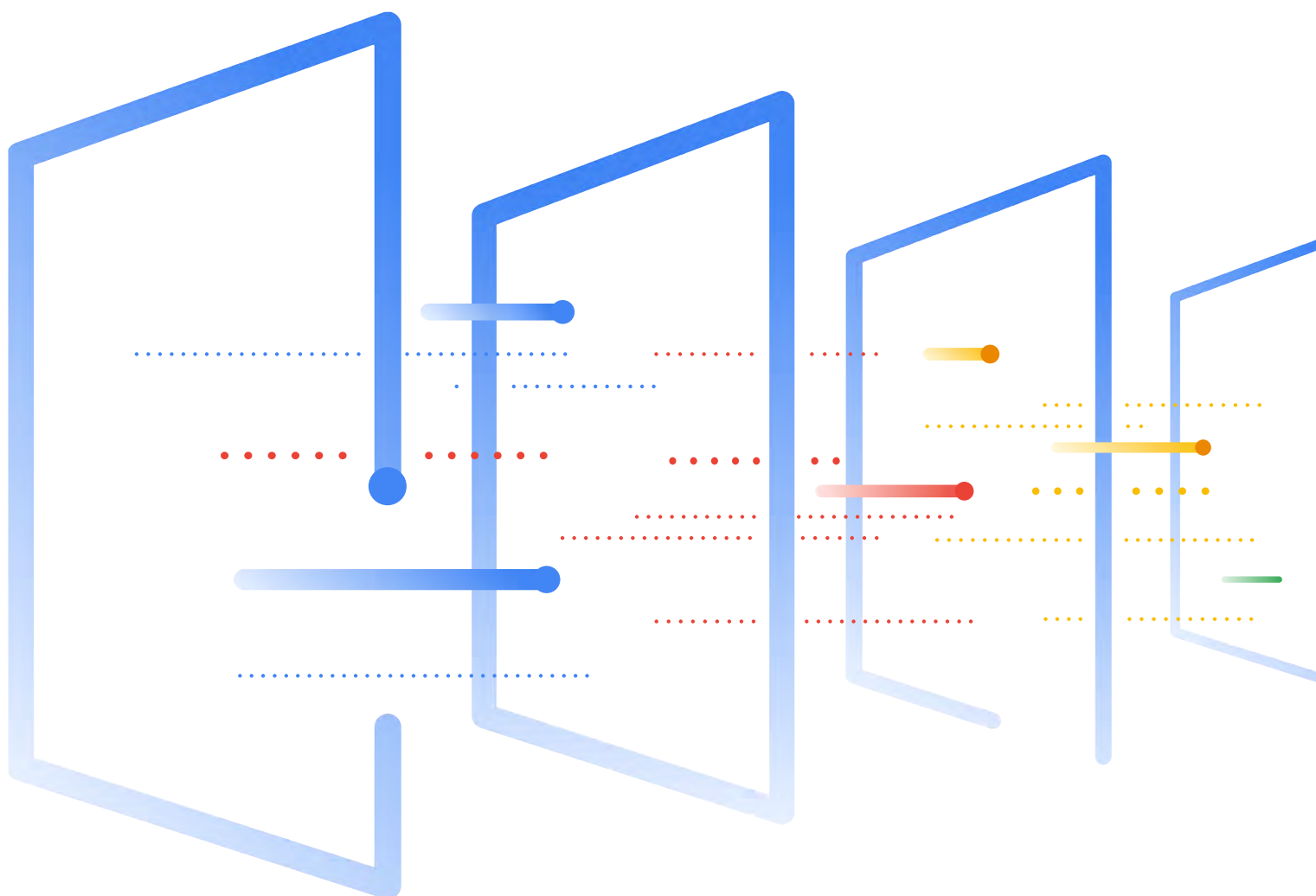

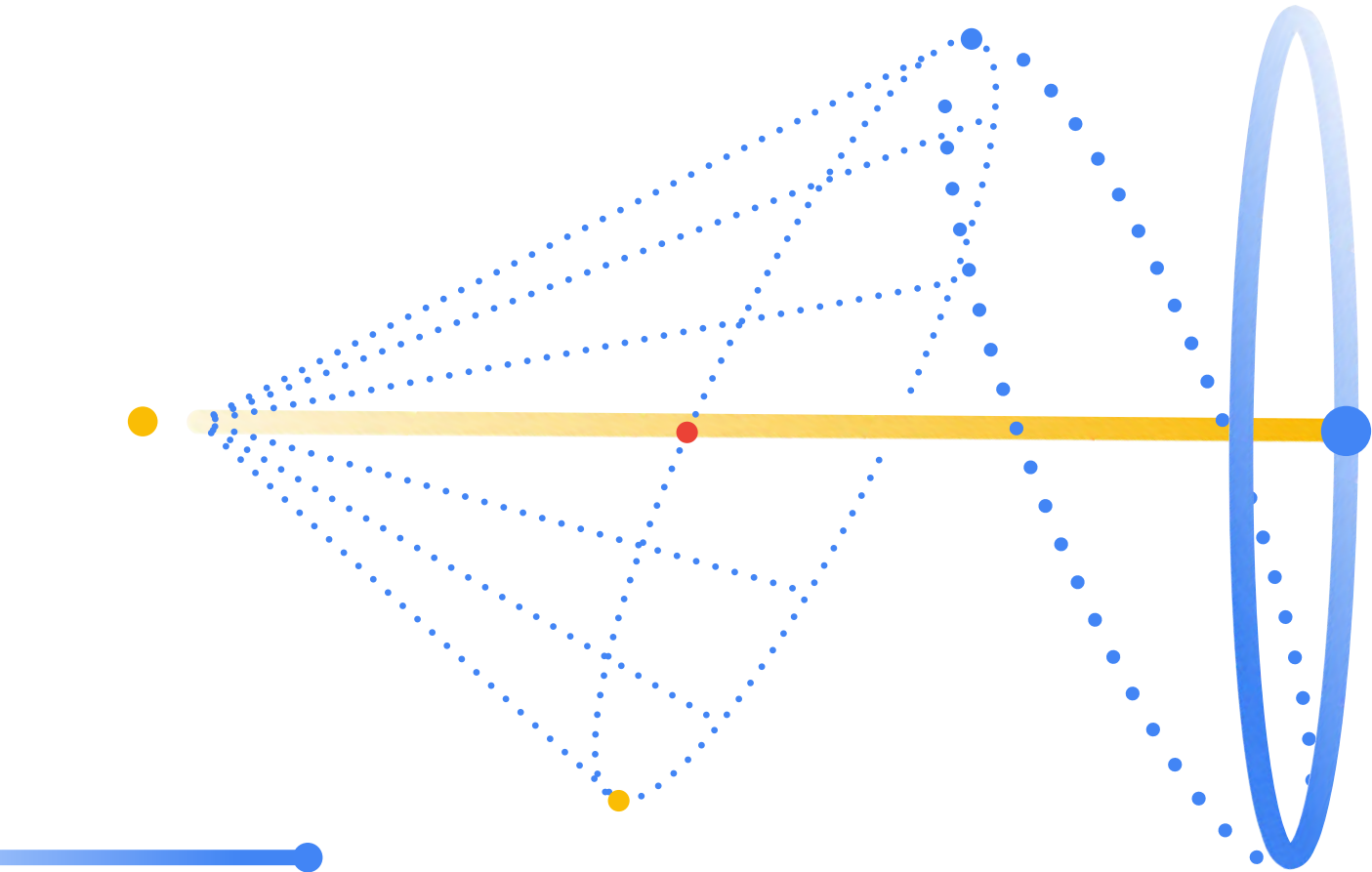
AI for Social Good
