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



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**Minutes of the meeting held in DIPP on 29.07.2013 to discuss the draft IPR Strategy.**

1. A meeting was held on 29.07.2013 in this Department under the Chairmanship of JS(DVP) to discuss the draft national IPR strategy.
2. A list of participants is attached at Annexure I.
3. While starting the meeting, JS(DVP) mentioned that the purpose of the meeting is to make the National IPR Strategy more comprehensive so that it can have a larger coverage of the issues related to the Intellectual Property. He invited Sh. N.K. Sabharwal, Member SIC on IPR, to throw more light on the draft strategy.
4. Sh. N.K. Sabharwal stated that the initiative taken to prepare a National IPR Strategy is a very important step by the Government of India as, so far, more than 40 countries in the World have their own IP strategy or policy. He mentioned that there are seven pillars of the IPR strategy as like creation, protection, administration, enforcement, commercialization, capacity building and integration of IP issues into National Policy. He mentioned that the needs and concerns of different Ministries with respect to the IPR strategy may be different and specific, however, there is a need to accommodate them in the draft strategy in order to make it more comprehensive. He requested all the participants to put forth their suggestions in the matter.
5. The representative of CSIR mentioned that the strategy should identify and address the gaps in the area of funding and incentives being provided to the R&D institutions and their needs and there should be a structure for providing incentive for R&D in private sector also.
6. Sh. Bala Prasad, Joint Secretary, Department of AYUSH mentioned that the subject of traditional knowledge including the issues as like trans boundary issues, sui-generis system for protection of TK, provisions of Biological Diversity Act, Negotiations in WIPO and Bio piracy should be incorporated in the National IPR Strategy.
7. The representative of ICAR mentioned that the strategy should consist of the concrete action plan for coming years. He further mentioned that there must be an Act in place for public funding of R&D in order to foster the innovation eco system in the country.
8. The representative of MSME mentioned about the scheme of National Manufacturing Competitiveness Programme being implemented by them in PPP model and informed that so far they have established 28 IP facilitation centers to provide guidance and assistance to the medium and small industries in the field of IP.

9. The representative of Ministry of Power mentioned that a brief module on IPR should be included in the high school curriculum to increase the awareness of IPR in public and there should be a uniform policy regarding incentive system for R&D in public funded institutions.
10. Sh. B.K. Singh, Director, Department of Pharmaceuticals mentioned that the draft National IPR strategy should be well within the TRIPS Agreement and there should be no initiative or commitment for any TRIPS plus measure. He further mentioned that they will be sending their comments after stake holders consultation in this regard shortly.
11. JS(DVP) requested all the participants to furnish their comments in written form to this Department within a week.
