ORDER

Special Medical Boards are being constituted by the Department of Health and Family Welfare from time to time for examination and certification of persons with disabilities in addition to the existing system of Issue of disability certificates by the Medical Boards of different Govt. Hospitals including teaching hospital to keep parity with the Govt. policy of early coverage of all persons with disabilities by examination and certification in special camps. It is found that in some of the disability certificates the name of the disease is being mentioned which perhaps is not understandable by any service provider as a non medical person.

It is hereby ordered that henceforth every Medical Board should mention percentage and type of disabilities only in the disability certificate i.e. Blind, Low vision, Locomotor Disability, Cerebral Palsy, Hearing Impairment, Mental Illness, Mental Retardation, Autism and multiple Disabilities etc. as defined in persons with Disabilities Act, 1995 and National Trust Act, 1999 without mentioning the name of the disease.
