**ORDER**

Medical Boards are being constituted by the Department of Health and Family Welfare from time to time for examination and certification of persons with disabilities. It is reported that ENT Surgeon of some Govt. Hospitals are demanding BERA test for ascertaining degree of disability on hearing in different Medical Camps for disability. But all the Govt. hospitals are not presently equipped with the provision of BERA test. It has accordingly been decided that though Brainstem Evoked Response Audiometry (BERA) test is superior to Audiometry for assesment of Hearing Impairment but until and unless all the Government hospitals are equipped with provisions of Brainstem Evoked Response Audiometry (BERA) test till then the existing arrangement of Audiometry test is to be carried out for assessment of hearing disability/impairment. No person should be refused certificate for want of report of Brainstem Evoked Response Audiometry (BERA) test or be insisted to get the report of BERA test from private clinic.
