**Terms of Reference:**

- (i) Review global Internet policy landscape and provide suggestions and inputs on issues related to Internet Governance taking into account the technical development and dynamically changing societal needs in the country.
- (ii) Serve as a platform for sharing of knowledge, experiences and expertise, including provision of legal, economic and technical inputs for developing a long term vision and leadership.
- (iii) MAG may build consensus among stakeholders on inputs to be provided to Inter-Ministerial Group on matters related to Internet Governance, for further consideration.

**Administrative Terms**

- (i) The Members of the IIGF MAG would be appointed on the basis of nominations given by respective stakeholder organisation.
- (ii) The tenure of the MAG will be for three years from the date of its constitution. The membership of the allocated members would be for a period of one year.
- (iii) The MAG may invite any other persons to the Group as special invitee.
- (iv) The group will meet at least once in six months.
- (v) TA/DA will be provided to the non-official members as per government norms.
