Assam Police Headquarters intends to purchase and install One No. Lawful Interception and Monitoring System, from the manufacturers, reputed authorized dealers, dealing with the subject. The specification/configuration/features of the required system are enclosed herewith as Annexures. Tenderers are advised to quote their rate after careful study of TENDER DOCUMENTS as well as following terms & conditions.

Intending tenderers may collect the tender papers/documents on payment of Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousands only) through uncrossed IPO/Bank Draft/ DCR payable in favour of the undersigned on any working day during office hours upto **20.01.2011**. They may also download the NIT from the Assam Police Website www.assampolice.com. In that case the tenderer will have to deposit the cost of tender document through uncrossed IPO/Bank Draft/DCR at the time of submission of tender.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Only Proprietorship Firms(F)/Companies (C) / Joint Ventures (JV) and Consortium of Companies(CC) would be eligible to apply, who meet the following criterion:
 - a. The bidding F/C / JV or CC should either be an Indian Company or have an Indian Company as a leading partner.
 - b. No bids directly from any F/C / JV / CC outside India would be accepted.
 - c. The bidding F/C / JV / CC should include an Original Manufacturer of the offered solution. Single bidding Company should necessarily be an Original Manufacturer of the offered solution. No bids from authorized representatives would be accepted.
 - d. The bidding Firm/Company or the leading firm in the JV or CC should have been in the business for a minimum period of 3 years. (Certificate of Incorporation or CA certificate is to be submitted).
 - e. The bidding F/C / JV / CC should have executed at least one order for Lawful Interception and Monitoring System (LIMS) in the last 3 years to any State Police, Law Enforcement Agency or Service Provider in India or abroad. (Copy of purchase order to be submitted along with the bid). The bidding F/C / JV / CC should have some documentary proof of having installed switch based Lawful Interception and Monitoring System for GSM, CDMA, PSTN with a minimum of 4 E1s in a single order.
 - f. JV / CCs can have a maximum of 4 members. In addition, total stake of Indian Co. / Cos. In JV / CC to be 50% or more with management control in JV to be with an Indian Co and with an Indian Citizen.
 - g. Also, in case of JV / CC, the responsibility for successful execution of the entire project will be that of the defined leading company.
 - h. The Firm/Company/JV/ CC must be well established and has been providing IT solutions for at least 3 years.

- i. The company/leading partner in case of JV/CC should have at least one technical support office in Guwahati.
 - j. Firm/Company/JV/Consortium of companies should have sufficient technical skilled manpower with relevant experience in developing and implementing customized IT applications and in integration of modern technologies.
 - k. The Firm/Company/JV/Consortium of companies should have proven experience in the field of development of customized applications, in the integration of interception Monitoring solutions on PSTN, CDMA, GSM with capability to up-grade to GPRS technologies.
2. The Original Equipment manufacturer must give a declaration confirming that the availability of service and support for the system is be guaranteed by them for a minimum period of 10 years.
3. Only Sales Tax payee agencies are eligible to fill this tender. Interested agencies shall quote their Sales Tax / TIN / VAT registration No. in their quotation and also attach documentary proof of having registered with Sales Tax Department for the sale of such systems with the technical bid. Copy of latest Sales Tax/VAT Clearance Certificate are also be attached.
4. A copy of tender documents terms & conditions duly signed by the bidder(s) in token to having understood and agreed the same should be attached with the technical bid.
5. Earnest money amounting Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees ten lacs only) in form of Bank Draft from any nationalized bank in India in favor of Inspector General of Police (MPC), Assam must be attached with technical bid. No tender shall be accepted without earnest money. Earnest money shall be refunded to the unsuccessful tenderer, after finalization of tender. Earnest money deposited with the tender shall bear no interest.
6. Percentage (%) of Sales Taxes & levies etc., if any, to be claimed shall be indicated clearly against each item, in the quotation otherwise it will be presumed that rates are inclusive of all taxes and no plea would be accepted in this regard after opening of the tenders.
7. Rates quoted shall be valid till the successfully supply, installation and commissioning of the system.
8. The prices shall be FOR Guwahati delivery including installation / commissioning / Training and statutory levies, if any.
9. Bidder must provide an affidavit stating that neither the bidder, principal supplier of equipments (hardware, software and accessories) or any associated /affiliated company is blacklisted by any Public Sector Undertaking / Agency of the Govt. of India, Govt of India and/or State Govt.
10. The bids received from unauthorized persons not empowered by the company/ Manufacture / Supplier will be treated as unresponsive and shall be summarily rejected. The supplier shall be responsible for completion of the system in all respects. He shall avoid involvement of any sub-contractor(s).

11. All disputes in this connection shall be settled in Guwahati jurisdiction only.
12. The supplier shall not assign in whole or part its obligation to perform under this contract to a third party, except with prior written consent of the purchaser.
13. The supplier shall not, without the prior permission and consent of the purchaser in writing, disclose the content of the contract or details in part or full or any provisions thereof or any specifications, plan, drawings, patterns, sample or information furnished on behalf of the purchaser in connection therewith to any person employed/engaged/sub-contracted by the supplier in the performance of the contract. Bidder must quote for all items and quantities as listed under the schedule of requirements.
14. Arithmetic errors will be rectified on the following basis. If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price, the unit price shall prevail and the total price will be corrected. If there is discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail.
15. The Earnest Money will be liable to be forfeited, if the bidder withdraws or amends or impairs or derogates from the tender in any respect within the period of validity.
16. The prices shall be quoted for complete system in the light of Annexures T-3, C-2 & C-3. .
17. Tenderers shall submit BIDS in 2(two) parts in separate sealed envelopes i.e., **TECHNICAL BID** and **PRICE BID**. Both these bids shall further be put in one envelop before putting in tender box, duly sealed. The bidders shall also superscribe on the individual envelope the category of bid. .
18. Terms & Condition dully signed and shall be attached with TECHNICAL BID duly filled in, alongwith all documentary proof, as specified in the Tender Terms & Conditions and other necessary documents required to assess the eligibility of the firm and the suitability of equipment/product. The price bid of only those firms will be opened, who will be found technically qualified in all respect.
19. Tenderers shall specify the period of delivery of system, from the date of confirmed supply order, in the quotation, which should not be more than 6-8 weeks. Incase, the firm fails to complete the supply either in part or whole, within stipulated period, penalty of 2% per week on the total cost of indented systems will be imposed on the firm, after expiry of the approved delivery period which shall be in force for another minimum two weeks, if then, supply/installation is not completed, legal action shall be initiated against the firms as per norms specified in the tender. The penalty shall be recovered from the outstanding dues/Security deposits/final bill etc.
20. Successful tenderer(s) shall also deposit SECURITY MONEY in from of Bank Draft or Bank Guaranty valid for a period of 3(three) years from the date of issue of supply order, of rupees to the value of 10% of the total supply order and execute a "DEED OF AGREEMENT" in non-judicial stamp paper of the denomination applicable for the

purpose.. The security deposits shall be submitted within a week's time from the date of confirmed supply order, failing which supply order can be cancelled. Security deposits shall also bear no interest. In case the firm fails to deposit the security money within the specified time, the E.M.D. will be forfeited in favour of department.

21. The security deposits shall be released only after the expiry of the warranty/guaranty period of the system. However, payment of the agency shall be released only after the supply/installation commissioning of system successfully.
22. The tender must contain the name office and residential address including telephone number(s) of the person or persons or firm in India, with their signatures. Un-signed tender shall not be accepted.
23. The tenderers should be qualified in the field and have good expertise. The tenderer(s) shall submit the documentary proof in this regard alongwith appreciation, if any, in support of his/her caliber.
24. Payment to the successful bidder would be released as per the following schedule:
 - a. 50% of the contract value to be released on the receipt of the required hardware & software against the required Bank Guarantee valid covering the warranty period..
 - b. Balance 50% shall be released only after the successful installation, training and commissioning and final acceptance of the system by the purchaser.
25. Tender envelop(s) must be sealed and superscribed "TENDER FOR PURCHASE OF LAWFUL INTERCEPTION and MONITORING SYSTEM" which shall be addressed to the Inspector General of Police (MPC), Assam Police Headquarters, B. K. Kakoti Road, Ulubari, Guwahati – 781007 and shall be deposited by post or put in Tender Box kept at Assam Police Headquarters, Guwahati. The department shall not be liable for any postal delays.No tender will be accepted after the due date and time.
26. No enquiry shall be made by the tenderer(s) during the course of examination of the tender, after the opening till final decision conveyed to the successful bidder(s). However, the Committee/its member(s) and Assam Police Headquarters, Guwahati can make any enquiry/seek clarification from the bidders and Tenderer(s) in such a situation the agency shall extend full co-operation.
27. The bidders can also be asked to arrange live demonstration of the system at Guwahati, within 7 days notice, for at least 3 Service Providers. The demonstration should show capturing of Target calls, SMS messages, Location, IMEI, IMSI and all the associated call related information (CRI). Correlation of CRI and Voice Calls should also be demonstrated.The Demonstration will have to be arranged by the bidder without any cost to Assam Police.
28. Any agency, which has exemption of earnest money deposits and security deposits, from Govt. of India's Deptt./Ministry, shall furnish a certified copy of such order, indicating therein clearly that they are exempted, failing which tender shall not be taken into consideration.

29. In case of differences and disputes arising between the purchaser and contractor, the same shall be settled by an arbitrator to be appointed by Director General of Police (DGP), Assam, whose decision will be binding on both the parties. In the event of the arbitrator dying, neglecting, refusing to act or being unable to act or resigning or his award being set aside by a court of law for any reason, shall be lawful for DGP, Assam to appoint another arbitrator in place of the outgoing arbitrator in the manner aforesaid. It is further a term of contract that no person other than the person appointed by the DGP, Assam as aforesaid should act as arbitrator and that if for any reason that is not possible, then the matter is not to be referred to arbitrator at all. The arbitrator may from time to time with the consent of all parties to the contract enlarge the time for making the award. Upon each and every such reference, the assessment of the costs incidental to the reference and award respectively shall be in the discretion of the arbitrator. Subject to the aforesaid, the Arbitration Act 1996 and the rules there under and any statutory modifications thereof for the time being in force shall be deemed to apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause. The venue of the arbitration shall be the place from which the formal acceptance of tender is issued or any other place decided by the DGP, Assam. If the value of the claim in reference exceeds Indian Rupees One lac the arbitrator shall give reasoned award.
30. The invitation to tender, the bid documents and the contract shall be interpreted in accordance to Indian laws and the jurisdiction of appropriate Indian courts based in Guwahati shall apply.
31. The supplier/contractor must indemnify the purchaser against all third party claims of infringement of patent, trademark or industrial design rights arising from the use of the goods or any part thereof.
32. The purchaser shall have the right to inspect or test the goods for conformity to the contract specifications. Such tests will be conducted at the premises of the supplier as well as at the premises of the purchaser or at the place specified by the purchaser. Necessary test equipment / jigs, fixtures and facilities for such a test shall be arranged by the supplier. The purchaser shall not make any payment to the supplier in this regard. If any goods fail to meet the specification the supplier shall replace them free of cost or make necessary additions/ alterations so as to ensure that goods meet the laid down technical specifications as in tender document. Complete documentation for such test and results thereof shall be given free of cost. The technical problems faced during testing, installation and commissioning shall be completely documented and shall be handed over to the purchaser at the time of delivery for future reference. The supplier shall provide, free of cost, all software and hardware details on CDs as well as hard copies. Complete operating and maintenance manuals shall be provided. Two copies of these documents be provided free of cost. Besides this, the supplier shall provide, free of cost following documents: -
- a. System interface drawings if any
 - b. System interconnection and block diagrams, if any
 - c. System built-up drawings, if any
33. The bidder shall undertake to supply necessary maintenance equipment and spare parts, for at least 7 years from the date of expiry of the warranty period, of the

equipment on continuing basis at a reasonable price not exceeding the price of spares quoted along with the tender. The bidder shall include in this tender a list of essential spares/items, their quantity and unit price on a separate sheet. In addition, the bidder shall indicate the list of recommended spares, their quantity and the unit cost required for efficient functioning of the system.

34. The supplier shall provide a comprehensive on site warranty for a period of three years. This clause is to be read along with any other special clause mentioned in the tender document and the technical specifications. The purchaser shall not pay for: –
 - a. Any incremental cost for SW upgrades during warranty period
 - b. Maintenance base, if any, to be created by supplier at purchaser's premises
 - c. Extra equipment required for meeting the performance criteria laid down in the tender document.
 - d. Cost of any spare parts and / or consumables of the system, hardware and software, supplied in whole or in part.
 - e. On site maintenance service
35. It will be imperative on the part of the supplier to fully associate the representatives of the purchaser in the maintenance of the system.
36. The Bidder shall provide at least 2(two) dedicated engineer at Central Site for online support, during the Warranty period who can rectify the problem, immediately. The undertaking must be signed by the original manufacturer and submitted alongwith the bid.
37. The supplier shall provide free training to the representatives of the purchaser as mentioned in the technical specification enclosed. Complete information regarding material to be covered and type of background of the trainees required be intimated to the purchaser at least 21 days in advance.
38. The supplier shall ensure correct packing and forward the goods to the purchaser at the destination indicated by the purchaser.
39. The purchaser may without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to the supplier terminate the contract in whole or part if the supplier fails to perform under the contract or fails to deliver any or all goods within the period specified in the contract.
40. The supplier shall not be liable to forfeiture of its performance security, liquidated damages or termination for default, if the delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligation under the contract is the result of an event of Force Majeure. For the purpose of the clause the term 'Force majeure' means an event beyond the control of the supplier and not involving the supplier or negligence and not foreseeable circumstances. Such event may include but are not restricted to the acts of the purchaser either in its sovereign or contractual capacity, wars or revolutions, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantines restrictions and foreign embargoes or any other act of god.

41. The supplier is required to provide hardware and software up-gradations from time to time at mutually agreed prices, terms and conditions. During the warranty period, such up-gradations will be free of cost. Incremental costs for up-gradations in the post warranty period shall be indicated in a separate sheet enclosed with commercial bid. However if the bugs/ shortcomings detected by the purchaser as well as the supplier during the lifetime of the equipment, the up-gradations/modifications/rectification in SW/HW shall be supplied by the supplier free of cost.
42. Tenderer(s) shall indicate make/model/product's name of the equipment in the tender alongwith complete specification and all technical features, in the technical bid.
43. Tenderers shall mention the warranty/guaranty period of systems in clear terms in the quotation, which should not be less than 3(THREE) years from the date of handing over the systems complete in all respect and successful installation/functioning satisfactorily (as mentioned in the technical specification).
44. Tenderers shall indicate their rates in clear/visible figures as well as in words and shall not alter/overwrite/make cutting in the tender. If any alteration/overwriting/cutting etc. is noticed the rates of such item shall not be considered.
45. Last date of submission of tender in the Assam Police Headquarters is latest by **3.00 PM on 21.01.2011**. Applying agencies/their representatives are at their liberty to attend the proceedings of opening of the tender (Technical Bid only) at **3.30 PM on 21.01.2011** in the Assam Police Headquarters. Incase the tenders are not opened on the fixed time & date due to any administrative reasons etc., the next date will be intimated in due course.
46. If the performance of any equipment or system fails to meet the contract specifications and not fulfill the requirements of purchaser then the firm shall replace that system free of cost, during the warranty/guarantee period, within shortest possible period, as decided by the Assam Police Headquarters. Incase of any defect/fault noticed during the warranty period that shall be attended within 4 hours by the qualified engineer of the agency.
47. The tenderers shall attach all the documentary proofs as asked for in Annexure-T3 (Technical Specifications) with the technical bid and also mention all the required information along with documentary proof.
48. All the engineers, Software experts and call desk attendant so deputed by the firm must be equipped with mobile phones.
49. The rates are to be quoted in Indian currency and payment shall also be made to successful bidders in Indian currency.
50. All the equipment of the system should be compatible to each other and with the existing system.

51. The successful bidder(s) will submit the documentary proof of having qualified engineers / workshop as well as technical infrastructure in Guwahati, to maintain the systems during the warranty/guarantee period. Also furnish a certificate of guarantee to maintain for at least 7 years during the post warranty/guarantee period, on reasonable rates as norms of AMC/Facility Management(FM) (as mentioned in the technical specification).
52. In case the successful tenderer(s) is found to have been involved in breach of any condition(s) at any stage during the warranty/guaranty period the legal action as per rules/laws, shall be initiated against the agency concerned. In that case, Earnest Money and Security deposits can be forfeited, besides debarring/Black listing the agency concerned for at least 5 years for further dealing.
53. Before opening the price bid, Assam Police through its any members or responsible officer can inspect and verify the genuineness of the Bidders Company and availability of infrastructure.
54. After award of work and during the installation till taking over the charge of complete systems, the equipment can be tested or put for test through approved technical agency/lab. If any equipment found sub-standard or otherwise, legal action shall be initiated against the firm as enumerated in forgoing terms & conditions.
55. After opening of the commercial bid, the purchaser reserves the right to negotiate with Selected firm/bidder.
56. Conditional tenders shall not be accepted at any cost and shall be rejected straightway.
57. Successful bidder(s), if shown inability/incapability to complete the project after acceptance of the tender, besides legal action, as enumerated above, difference of higher cost, if the work/supply is/are got completed from other tenderer(s)/any agency from market, would be recovered from the earnest money/security deposits of the tenderer(s).
58. Assam Police, without assigning any further reason shall reject any tender(s) in which any prescribed conditions(s) is/are found incomplete in any respect.
59. The Assam Police reserves the right to keep a panel of qualified tenderer(s).
60. The Assam Police also reserves the right to relax any of the above-mentioned conditions(s) and reject on its discretion any or all tenders altogether without assigning any reason in public interest.
61. The Assam Police also reserves the right to award/supply order on quality/technical basis, which depends on quality/capability of the system. Tenderer(s) are, therefore, directed to also submit the technical features of the systems. Tenderers should not have any objection in this regard.
62. No advance payment shall be made in any circumstances.

63. The specifications laid down in the NIT are the minimum configuration of the systems / items. Systems / items of better / higher configuration or better technology may be quoted for consideration.
64. The tenders which do not fulfill all the terms and conditions of the tender notice will be summarily rejected without any reference to the tenderer and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
65. Once the rates offered in the quotation are accepted, no enhancement will be entertained at any circumstances and tenderers will be liable to supply the items at the rate accepted by the Assam Police. Failure to supply the items at the accepted rates will entail the offer being cancelled and the Security Money will be forfeited to the Govt. of Assam.
66. The Director General of Police, Assam does not bind himself to accept the lowest rate and may reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason thereof.
67. The Director General of Police, Assam reserves the right not to place any order even after execution / acceptance of the formal contract agreement and for which no claim or compensation whatsoever will be entertained.
68. If the successful tenderer willfully neglects, fails to perform or observe any or all conditions of the contract agreement or attempts to cheat or indulge in foul practices, the Director General of Police, Assam may impose a ban upon such tenderer (s) for future business within the Department besides the power to initiate criminal prosecution against the firm
69. Performance Security @ 5% of the total value of supply order has to be deposited by the supplier in the manner specified in Para 20 above at the time of signing of Deed of Agreement as mentioned in Para 20 above to ensure satisfactory performance of the equipments supplied for a period of 5 (five) years from the date of acceptance of product. This deposit will be released in due course after the expiry of specified period.
70. The bill may be submitted to this headquarters and payment thereof will be made only after :

- (i) satisfactory receipt by the Receiving Committee to be constituted for the purpose
- (ii) satisfactory certification on the supply by concerning authorized person / committee for the purpose.
- (iii) successful completion of training to Assam Police personnel as referred in NIT.

- (iv) Copy of Income Tax Return for last 2 (two) years.

- (vii) Certificate from Competent Authority regarding claim of EMD exemption.
- (viii) Technical specifications of the product offered along with literature/brochure if any.
- (ix) Document regarding Solvency.
- (x) Signed term & condition copy of the tender shall be attached.
- (xi) All other supporting documents as required in the tender shall be attached.
- (xii) Training scheduled manuals must be attached.
